

Grain Valley Eagles Football Booster Club Meeting Minutes

The GV Eagles Football Booster Club met on Monday, May 2, 2011 in the library of GVHS.

Pratt called the meeting to order.

Car Wash: We are ready to go on this for this Saturday, May 7th.

Eagles in the Valley: This was rained out. We will try again for June or August.

Equipment Trailer: Scot and Pratt are looking at a trailer we might be able to purchase for the team to use for away games to hold equipment. Coach Tucker would like one, possibly 12-15 foot (tandem) for use at all away games. The band has agreed to let us use their trailer for use at MU Camp.

MU Camp: Coach Tucker will be having a meeting a few nights before the MU camp to answer any questions. He did confirm that we will be taking school equipment for use at the camp.

Thursday night meals: This will be open to all players, freshman through varsity and will be held in the high school commons. It may be held off site one or two times if there are scheduling problems with other sports or activities. There was discussion about the menu, but that can be finalized at a later date. When the meal is held somewhere other than the school, the food will be donated and/or gathered by parents as we have done in the past. This is a team function that parents are asked to assist with. This is not really a booster function, but many of our members can assist. Meals at the school will be prepared by the kitchen staff and we may assist as needed.

Food for Friday Night Games: It has not been decided yet if we will be able to feed the boys a hot meal, as we have done the past few years, prior to home games, but Coach Tucker has said he would like sandwiches and fruit after each game, both home and away. Long distance away games like Blair Oaks in Jefferson City could require a before and after meals. Funds for game day meals will come from camp dues and other funding, as needed, will be paid through the boosters. Home game meals will be optional for each player and collected by the boosters. The coaches will provide a count for each game and players will decide for the entire season if they will be eating. Players who can drive or make arrangements will be allowed to leave the school and return after they have eaten if they choose not to participate in the booster meal program.

7 on 7: This is still in the works and schedules are being worked out.

Game film: There will be no Saturday morning game film, so no need for the donuts etc that we have provided in the past. Coach Tuck may have this on a Sunday afternoon. It's still in the works and the players may attend if they'd like.

Value Cards Fundraiser: Coach Tucker will do a fundraiser with the boys on discount saver cards approximately the second week of August. The money raised will be deposited with the boosters. This could raise \$15,000 to \$17,000, according to Coach Tucker. More info to come on that.

Coaches Wish List: Coach Tucker would like a video camera (first priority), a laptop and a new battle shoot for the field. Hudl.com is paid for for next season. There was some discussion about a water cooler, would it be beneficial for the team. Can we keep it well cleaned?

Media Day: This will be on Saturday August 13th. There may be a scrimmage, a mother's clinic, pictures, news media and perhaps a pancake breakfast.

Thursday Night Meals: These will be held at the Methodist Church will possibly a few at the high school. They would like the Mama Eagles to serve these meals. Possible menus will be lasagna, tacos, etc.

Varsity Away Games: The team will receive box lunches and will be fed on the bus on the way home.

Adjournment:

The motion to end the meeting at 7:35 was made and the motion carried.

The next meeting date is set for Tuesday June 7, 2011 in the library at GVHS.
